“my situation is different” “I have an excuse for my sin”	There is no trial that has overtaken you but such as <i>is common to man</i>	“Stop making excuses for my sin because no matter my situation, Jesus will hold me accountable”
“I can’t do this”	There is no trial that has overtaken you but such as <i>is common to man</i>	“I can get through this because other Christians have and continue to get through this ‘common’ issue with God’s grace. I must act responsibly and obediently to God”
“I don’t know anyone who can help me” “I can’t ‘counsel’ anyone in their problems”	There is no trial that has overtaken you but such as <i>is common to man</i>	“If my problem is common, then other Christians have gone through my situation and can help me” OR “I should share how God’s grace helped me with others”
“I have tried everything and nothing works” “Can God really help me”	There is no trial that has overtaken you but such as is common to man, and <i>God is faithful ...</i>	“The world may say there are no guarantees and men let me down, but God gives a guarantee and there is no fine print. I will face this situation with hope.”--“I will stop shifting the blame, I will confess my sin and act in obedience to God”
“I can’t do it” “What God wants is too hard”	There is no trial that has overtaken you but such as is common to man, and God is faithful who will <i>not allow you to be tried beyond what you are able to endure</i>	“Because God is faithful, I will trust him to give me the strength I need when I need it and not worry about the future. I will remember the strength comes in the doing of God’s word.
“I’m trapped” “There is no way out” “I’m in a box”	There is no trial that has overtaken you but such as is common to man, and God is faithful who will not allow you to be tried beyond what you are able to endure, <i>but with the trial also will make a way of escape in order that you may be able to endure it</i>	“God is faithful, I will not cop out. Jesus provided me a way out of eternal death, so God will provide a way out if I am obedient”.
