

- 6. Share a specific time in your life when someone spoke the Word of Christ in a way that admonished you truth in a necessary way.
- 7. Share a specific time in your life when someone sang a song that ministered to you.
- 8. As you think about the relational flow of the Word of God through you to others how are you challenged in regard to being a person who is to:
 - a. Teach others
 - b. Admonish others
 - c. Sing with thankfulness to God
- 9. What do you think it means for a person to go to work in the name of Jesus, or be a homemaker in the name of Jesus, or go to school in the name of Jesus?
