

READIOSITY

BEING READY TO BE GENEROUS

Readiosity is a word we created to champion the quality of being ready to be generous. Readioisty is important because people often experience needs that are unexpected. We desire to be ready to help meet the physical needs of our community.

HERE'S SOME RECENT EXAMPLES OF NEEDS MET.

- 1. A college student attending Alpha was in a car accident. Her parents had passed away and she had no help. We were able to help her buy a car so she could continue working, going to school, and attending Alpha.
- 2. We helped a veteran (also an Alpha attendee) pay off medical bills and helped her with a place to stay when she was in between apartments. There were some issues that were keeping the apartment from being ready to move into and she had nowhere to go.
- 3. Several CFC members lost their spouses this year. We were able to help pay for funeral and burial costs, lawyer fees, and miscellaneous costs that come up when someone passes away.
- 4. We covered airline costs for some commended missionaries who needed to be back in the US unexpectedly.
- 5. Helped a single mom and her two sons as they navigated life after she lost her job. We were able to provide groceries, clothing, and new work uniforms when she was hired for a new job.
- 6. We helped a man who attended Alpha with car repairs. He had just purchased a new-to-him car because his old car died. Then a few weeks after the purchase, the new car started having major issues. He was unable to get to work until the car was repaired.
- 7. We were able to provide a rental car for a single mom while she waited for repairs on her car after she was in a car accident. This enabled transportation to and from work and the ability to get her 4 kids to school.
- 8. A family was displaced because of a flood in their house. We provided gift cards to help them with additional costs of being displaced.
- 9. Some CFC members were out of work due to covid and we were able to provide gift cards to help with the loss of work.
- 10. Before Thanksgiving a turkey and \$100 were donated. We were able to help out a young single mom with Thanksgiving dinner.
