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Application Questions

Why do you think worry is sometimes (or frequently) still present in your life as a child of God? What would need to happen for worry to be a decreasing reality in your life?
6. How does the image of your body being the dwelling place of God clarify your understanding of your Christian life?
7. How does the image of being a component or part of a whole new building of God clarify your understanding of your Christian life?
