1.	Read Ephesians 5:1-2 and John 13:1-15
2.	What about the sermon and/or Scripture encouraged you the most and why?
3.	If you are doing these questions as a FG please be sure to ask if there are any needs in the group that the group could meet.
4.	Do you have a personal story of how someone loved you by meeting a need in your life?
5.	Identify at least one need (at CFC or in your neighborhood, or at your work) that you know that you can and will meet.
6.	In the story of the Good Samaritan, 2 people saw a need and walked by, but one person stopped and met the need. What needs are you honestly tempted to walk by (even though they are obvious to you)? What thoughts do you think that keep you from meeting the need?
7.	Do you have a few people in your life that are hard to love? What makes them hard for you to love? What would motivate you to love them even though they are hard to love?
8.	Sometimes our lack of love is not because people are hard to love, but our own life is extra hard. When has the hard in your own life kept you from loving other? If you are married, have you seen this happen in your marriage?
