### OUR RELATIONSHIP TO ONE ANOTHER

#### **Belong to one another**

Rom 12:4-5 so in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

Eph 4:25 Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to his neighbor, for we are all members of one body

1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

#### **Be likeminded one to another**

Rom 12:16 Live in harmony with one another.

1 Cor 1:10 I appeal to you, brothers, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another so that there may be no divisions among you and that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought.

### OUR RECEPTION OF ONE ANOTHER

#### **Be non-judgmental of one another**

Rom 14:3-4 The man who eats everything must not look down on him who does not, and the man who does not eat everything must not condemn the man who does, for God has accepted him.

James 5:8-9 Don't grumble against each other, brothers, or you will be judged. The Judge is standing at the door!

#### **Greet one another**

1 Cor 16:20 All the brothers here send you greetings. Greet one another with a holy kiss.

Rom 16:16 Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ send greetings.

1 Peter 5:14 Greet one another with a kiss of love.

#### **Be hospitable one to another**

1 Cor 11:33-34 So then, my brothers, when you come together to eat, wait for each other.

1 Peter 4:9 Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.

## **OUR RESPONSE TO ONE ANOTHER**

### **Love one another**

Rom 12:10-11 Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves.

1 Thess 4:9 Now about brotherly love we do not need to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love each other

1 Peter 1:22 Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for your brothers, love one another deeply, from the heart.

John 13:34-35 A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

1 Thess 3:12 May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you

1 John 4:7 Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.

1 John 3:11 This is the message you heard from the beginning: We should love one another.

1 John 3:23-24 And this is his command: to believe in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, and to love one another as he commanded us.

1 John 4:11 Dear friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.

1 John 4:12 No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us.

2 John 4-6 And now, dear lady, I am not writing you a new command but one we have had from the beginning. I ask that we love one another. And this is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands. As you have heard from the beginning, his command is that you walk in love.

John 15:17 This is my command: Love each other.

1 Peter 4:8 Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins.

### **Humility**

Rom 12:10 Be devoted to one another in brotherly love. Honor one another above yourselves.

Eph 5:21 Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

John 13:13-15 Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.

Phil 2:3-4 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. 4 Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others.

1 Peter 5:5 Young men, in the same way be submissive to those who are older. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, because "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

### **Care**

1 Cor 12:25-26 so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part rejoices with it.

Eph 4:1-2 Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love

Gal 6:2 Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.

1 Peter 3:8-9 Finally, all of you, live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic, love as brothers, be compassionate and humble.

1 Thess 5:14-15 Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always try to be kind to each other and to everyone else.

### **Serve**

Gal 5:13-14 You, my brothers, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, serve one another in love.

Heb 10:24-25 And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds.

## **OUR RESTORATION OF ONE ANOTHER**

### **Restore one another**

Gal 6:1 Brothers, if someone is caught in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently. But watch yourself, or you also may be tempted.

### **Admonish one another**

Rom 15:14 I myself am convinced, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, complete in knowledge and competent to instruct one another

### **Edify on another**

Rom 14:19 Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification.

Heb 3:13-14 But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called Today, so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.

1 Thess 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

Rom 1:11-12 I long to see you so that I may impart to you some spiritual gift to make you strong- that is, that you and I may be mutually encouraged by each other's faith

**Forgive one another**

Col 3:13 Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Eph 4:32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

**Speak to one another**

Col 3:9 Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices

James 4:11 Brothers, do not slander one another. Anyone who speaks against his brother or judges him speaks against the law and judges it.

Eph 5:19 Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord,

James 5:15-16 Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective.

John 16:19 Jesus saw that they wanted to ask him about this, so he said to them, "Are you asking one another what I meant when I said, 'In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me'?"

**Be at peace with one another**

Gal 5:15 If you keep on biting and devouring each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.

Gal 5:26 Let us not become conceited, provoking and envying each other.
