5. Does it encourage you to know that God in His providence will work in the brokenness you identified in #1 above such that His glorious attributes are displayed AND his children who treasure Him will experience such joy and delight that praise will be the natural overflow of their hearts? Do you believe that is true? Why or Why not?
6. When you think of the brokenness you identified in #1 above, what promises of scripture encourage you? Share with the group how you can pray that such promise will be fulfilled in the brokenness you identified. Be specific.
7. What are you currently doing to learn and remember the promises of God?
8. How can you make your prayers for the brokenness you identified in #1 effective?
9. Do you regularly and specifically confess your sins to God and to those who you sin against? If not, why not?
