5. Do you think there are circumstances where "it is unreasonable" for God to require obedience to His Word? Explain your answer.
6. Read 1 Corinthians 10:13-4. How does this verse encourage you?
7. The Scriptures says God is always with us and in us. God also sees what is being done to us and how we respond. How mindful are you of these truths on a daily basis? How do these truths affect the way you act and speak?
8. Are you in a situation right now where you do not know or understand from the Scriptures what obedience to God looks like? If you said yes, will you ask a Christian friend for help?
