These questions are designed to help you understand how God's Word applies to your life personally.

- 1. Read Luke 2:8-14
- 2. What was encouraging or challenging for you from today's message and/or scripture?
- 3. If you were to share the Gospel in 60 seconds, what would you say?
- 4. If you were to share the Gospel from one verse, what verse would you use? Why? If you could use 3 verses, which would you use?
- 5. What bible verses best show our need for salvation? What verses best show God's provision through Jesus?
- 6. If you knew the Gospel before you received the Gospel, what kept you from receiving it immediately?
- 7. As you think about your literal residential neighbors and work neighbors:
 - a. How certain are you that they have heard the true gospel of grace? What could you do to be sure they have heard?
 - b. Do you know who has received the gift of salvation and who has not?
 - c. If you know some have NOT received Christ, do you know why they have not received it?
 - d. If you don't know why, how could you engage them in that conversation to learn why not? (This is a way to practice the "L" of "Listen" in BLESS)
- 8. Who could you invite to our Christmas eve services to hear the Gospel?
- 9. Read Romans 10:12-15. How are you participating in helping those around the world who have never heard the Gospel to hear the Gospel? Would you consider partnering with one of our commended missionaries who are working to reach the unreached?
