



These questions are designed to help you understand how God's Word applies to your life personally.

1. Read Acts 1
2. What encouraged or challenged you from the teaching and/or scripture today?
3. What do you think the disciples thought when Jesus said, "It is not for you to know the time and epochs (dates)"? What do you think about not knowing the "when" of the future?
4. Does knowing what God says will happen in the future alter how you interpret what occurs in the present? If so, how? If not, why not?
5. In Acts 1:7-8 Jesus turns the focus of the disciples from the curiosity of the "when" to the mission of "Be my witnesses". What specifically does Jesus want them to do when He says, "be my witnesses"?
6. Do you think this command to "be my witnesses" applies to you? Why? If you have never seen Jesus, how can you "be his witnesses"?
7. If you believe you are to be one of His witnesses, would you commit to the Lord to speak the Gospel to at least one person this week? What will be the biggest hurdle for you to get over to make that happen?
8. What do you think would happen if every believer in Jacksonville spoke the Gospel to one person this week?
