James: The Truth We Need to Know When We Are Suffering, Cheerful, or Sick

These questions are designed to help you understand how God's Word applies to your life personally.

1. Read James 5:13-18
2. What encouraged and/or challenged you from today's sermon?
3. What specific Scriptures encourage you when you are suffering?
4. What attributes of God do you lean upon when you suffer? How does the character of God encourage you to endure in suffering?

9. Have you ever experienced or witnessed the Lord healing someone? How has that impacted your faith?
10. How would you encourage someone who has ask the Lord for healing, but has not experienced healing?
