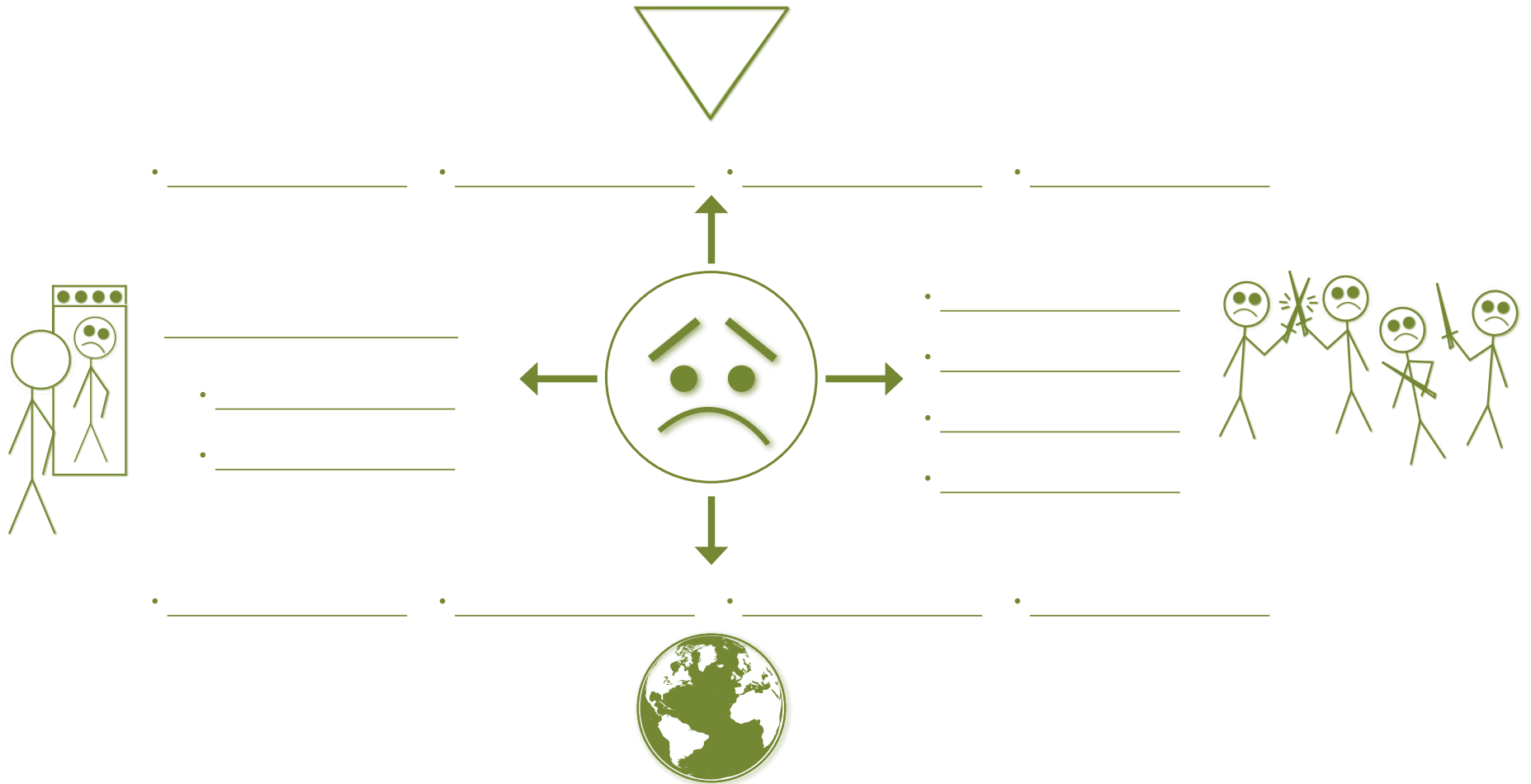

The Unraveling of Everything Good

Genesis 3

LOOK BACK

- **Praise:** Read Psalm 32
Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done. (How have you seen him work, answered a prayer, blessed you or someone else)

The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What is hard in your life that you will, by faith, give thanks for?

- **Confession:** In what ways are your thoughts and actions not in line with God's Word?

LOOK IN

- What did Genesis 3 reveal about temptation? How do you experience the same pattern of temptation at work in your own life?
- How has sin unraveled what God intended humanity to experience personally?
- How do you see shame and fear robbing you of the life God intended for you?
- How did the sin of Adam and Eve unravel marriage as God has intended marriage to function?
- How do you experience futility and toil in your life?
- How did God demonstrate mercy to a disobedient Adam and Eve?
- The life God intended for humanity unraveled when Eve doubted the goodness of God's Word. How have you seen that same reality play out in your life?

LOOK FORWARD

- **BLESS:** Ask someone you know to lunch or coffee this week and familiarize yourself with the "Listen with Care" resource. Listen to their story and ask intentional questions.
- Closing Prayer
 - Requests: What are you asking God to do in the coming week?
 - Relinquishment: Present your body to be God's instrument to work in and though for His glory.
