LOOK BACK

- **Praise: Psalm 63**

Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done. (How have you seen him work, answered a prayer, blessed you or someone else)

The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What is hard in your life that you will, by faith, give thanks for?

- **Confession:** *Who or what is competing for your love and devotion to Jesus?*

LOOK IN

- What did you learn about your own relationship with Jesus as we reviewed Jesus' conversation with Peter?
- Read Luke 5:1-11. How do you think this event (which would have occurred months earlier) impacted Peter's experience in John 21?
- Read James 4:4-7. What do you think James means by "But He gives a greater grace"? How have you experienced a greater grace?
- How is the Holy Spirit informing, reminding, convicting, and encouraging you?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
