Killing Pride and Cultivating Humility

LOOK BACK

- **Praise: Isaiah 66:2 and Psalm 145**

Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done. (How have you seen him work, answered a prayer, blessed you or someone else?)

The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What is hard in your life that you will, by faith, give thanks for?

- **Confession:** What specific prideful words, actions, or reactions do you need to confess to God?

LOOK IN

- Read Daniel 4:34-37. List all the truths he has learned about God through the 7 years.
- Which of the above truths are important in your own pursuit of killing pride and cultivating humility?
- How does giving God praise kill pride?
- How does confession kill pride in your life? Is pride at the root of any of your refusal to confess?
- Read John 13:3-4,13-14. Jesus humbly does what no one else is willing to do. What would it look like for you to follow His example at home? At CFC? At work?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
