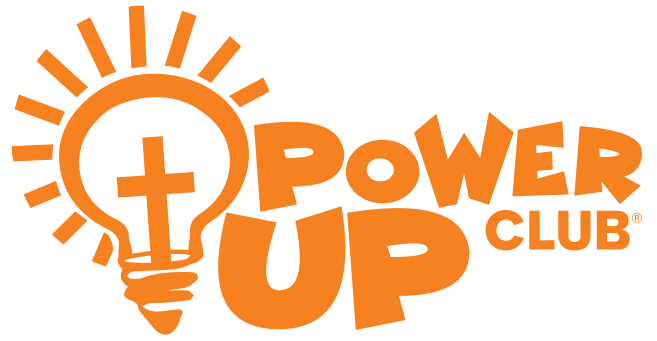


WHAT DOES AN ADULT LEADER DO?



A Power Up Club Adult Leader is more than just a driver. Here are a few more things to consider when being an Adult Leader:

- Adult Leaders (AL) should have a heart for leading teenagers and adults (a Team).
- ALs serve as the "Captain's Assistant," responsible for driving, team paperwork and details, and Host Home connection with the Team.
- ALs should be a Christ follower, spiritually mature, patient, and have leadership skills. They should be a member or regular attender of CFC.
- The AL role is not a demanding role with regard to preparation. There is a significant time commitment required during Leadership Training and Power Up Club week.
