## WHO SHOULD BE A HOST HOME?



- · A Christ follower
- · A member or regular attender of CFC
- · A family with a home that is within 30 minutes / 20 miles from CFC
- · A home with a front yard in a neighborhood with children
- · A person with a servant's heart willing to BLESS others

## WHAT DOES A HOST HOME DO?

- · Provide a front yard for the Power Up Club
  - Invite children and families from your neighborhood (we provide save the date cards & invitations)
  - · Start early with save the date cards
  - Be creative with invitations! For Example: Invite children from your child's class at school, sports team, dance class, or if you have social media, make a post. You can also share in neighborhood groups.
  - Put the PUC yard signs up early to advertise
- · During the week of PUC provide:
  - · A garden hose or two
  - · A place to sign in, a table works great
  - $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  A water cooler, 3 oz cups, and a trashcan
  - Pre-packaged snacks for kids (chips, pretzels, popcorn, popsicles, goldfish, etc.)
- · Greet your guests and get to know the adults and children who attend
- · Help gather guest information by helping them register using the QR code provided
- · Report attendance at your club each day after you club

Think of it this way, if you were going to host a party, what would you do? You would provide a space for the party, provide drinks and snacks, and provide a purpose for that party (games, entertainment, etc.).
