## God's Strategy for Multiplying

### LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Psalm 40:1-5**  
Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done. (How have you seen him work, answered a prayer, blessed you or someone else?)

The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What is hard in your life that you will, by faith, give thanks for?

- **Confession:** Consider how you may have disconnected loving God from loving your neighbor.

### LOOK IN

- Read Matthew 22:36-40. Why does Jesus tie loving your neighbor to loving God?
- Read Luke 10:30-37. What does this story teach you about loving your neighbor?
- As you consider the people God has providentially put in your path residentially, occupationally, recreationally, and “accidentally” take a moment to think through and then list by name which of them will you:
  - Pray for?
  - Schedule a meal with them in order to listen to their story?
  - Do an act of service for in the next 14 days?
  - Share your story or God’s story?
- How can you use the resources you received in the service to accomplish one of the above?
- What are your thoughts on the idea that the Great Commandment is God’s strategy for the Great Commission?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?

### LOOK FORWARD

- Closing Prayer
  - Requests: What are you asking God to do in the coming week?
  - Relinquishment: Present your body to God as an instrument to work in and through for His glory.
