## Show Me the Way

### LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Psalm 42:** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)

The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What problematic situation in your life will you, by faith, give thanks for?

- **Confession:** Take a few quiet moments to invite the Holy Spirit to reveal any struggles you've had with fully embracing Jesus' statement in John 14:6, when you've doubted the exclusivity of Christ as the only path to salvation, or when you've faltered in fully trusting His words.

### LOOK IN

- **Read John 14:7-15**
  - Compare and contrast what Jesus said to Thomas in John 14:5-6 and His words to Philip in John 14:8-9.
  - What can we gather from these two brief conversations that help us understand Jesus' intent for me as a follower? What is He saying about the "way," and what does He reveal about the Father?
- **Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-5**
  - According to Paul's statement in this passage, what is the Gospel?
  - As you consider your role as a follower of Jesus, what is your process (how will you explain) for how you will share the Gospel as truth with a lost neighbor?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
- For Further Study: Read these passages to deepen your understanding.
  - Acts 4:1-12
  - John 10:7-10
  - 1 Tim. 2:1-8
  - Matt. 11:25-30
