### LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Psalm 5**  
Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done. (How have you seen him work, answered a prayer, blessed you or someone else?)

The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What is hard in your life that you will, by faith, give thanks for?

- **Confession:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?

### LOOK IN

- Read Luke 5:30-32. How does the doctor analogy help you understand the heart of Jesus?
- Read Luke 9:51-56. When have you been more interested in God “punishing someone than saving that person?” Why do feel that way towards some?
- Read Luke 19:1-10. Jesus says He is in Zacchaeus’s house because He has come to SEEK the lost. What would it look like for you to become like Jesus in SEEKING the lost?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?

### LOOK FORWARD

- Closing Prayer
  - Requests: What are you asking God to do in the coming week?
  - Relinquishment: Present your body to God as an instrument to work in and through for His glory.
