LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?

LOOK IN

- Read Galatians 2:11-14
- Has there been a time when you have enjoyed Christian fellowship with Christians from other cultures? How would you describe that experience.
- How did Peter act hypocritically?
- How have you acted hypocritically in the past (or been tempted to)?
- How have you used hypocrisy blind people to the Glory of the Gospel of Grace?
- Recall to mind a time you experienced the fear of man.
- When you look back at your sins, is your tendency to look back with shame or to respond with awe at the love of Christ?
- As you think of growing in AWE of God, what will you do (or continue to do) to grow in love of God, knowledge of God and obedience to God. Please be specific. If you are discussing this in a family group seek to encourage each other and hold each other accountable in this area.
