## The Fullness of Freedom To Love

### LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Read Psalm 100-**(Note vs. 1 emphasizes serving with gladness) Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- **Confession:** How has selfishness been present in your life in the last week?

### LOOK IN

- Read Galatians 5:13-15 out loud.
- How can freedom in Christ be twisted and used as an excuse for sinning?
- Why does yielding to the desires of your flesh never satisfy? How have you experienced this reality personally?
- How is love the one-word summary for all that God commands?
- Are love and serving inseparable? Can you love and not serve? Can you serve and not love? Explain.
- How will lack of love be the end of meaningful community among believers?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
- For Further Study: Read these passages to deepen your understanding.
  - 1 Corinthians 13
  - Colossians 3:12-17
  - 1 Thessalonians 4:1-12
  - 1 Peter 4:7-11

### LOOK FORWARD

- Closing Prayer
  - Requests: What are you asking God to do in and through you in the coming week?
  - Relinquishment: Present your body to God as an instrument to work in and through for His glory.
