

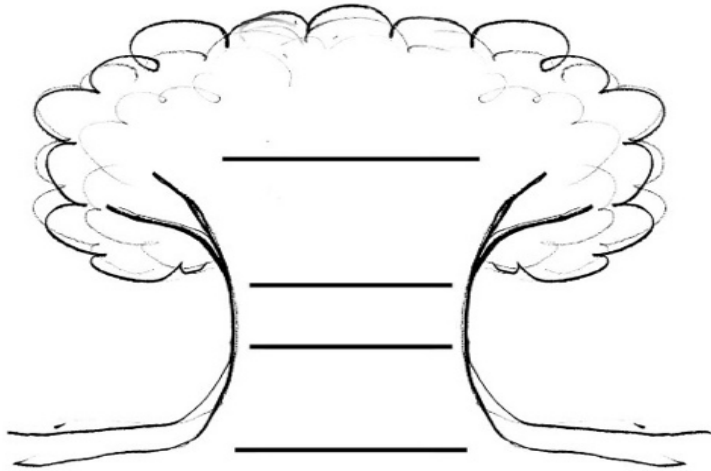

LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Read Psalm 19:7-14:** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What difficult circumstance in your life will you, by faith, give thanks for?
- **Confession:** How is the business and the busyness of the season causing you to miss the blessing of the season?

LOOK IN

- Remembering 2024, what scriptures have been a constant source of strength, encouragement, or transformation in your life? And how have those scriptures changed me?
- How has meditating on God's Word or memorizing it helped you persevere through the past year's struggles? Were there moments when having specific scripture memorized could have helped you?
- What methods of meditation will you use to engage in God's word in 2025?
- Who will you intentionally invite into your life in 2025 to encourage and challenge you with scripture and the promises of God's word?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
