🔵 LOOK BACK

- As you read Acts 13:1-3, it is clear that the Holy Spirit called Saul and Barnabas to a very specific work. What do you think the Holy Spirit has called you to do?
- What is the Biblical basis for a local church making financial provision for those who spiritually lead them?
- Read Acts 18:1-5. How did Paul benefit from the arrival of Silas and Timothy? Who else benefited?
- What do you learn about giving to help missionaries from Philippians 4:15-20?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
