Principles for Spreading Glory

LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Read Psalm 20:** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What difficult circumstance in your life will you, by faith, give thanks for?
- **Confession:** What is keeping you from intentionally pouring your life out for the sake of the faith of others?

LOOK IN

- As you look at Acts 1:8 and Acts 8:1, how do you think the apostles would have explained this contradiction?
- As you read Acts 13:1-3, it is clear that the Holy Spirit called Saul and Barnabas to a very specific work. What do you think the Holy Spirit has called you to do?
- What is the Biblical basis for a local church making financial provision for those who spiritually lead them?
- Read Acts 18:1-5. How did Paul benefit from the arrival of Silas and Timothy? Who else benefited?
- What do you learn about giving to help missionaries from Philippians 4:15-20?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
