LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: John 14:12-31** (*emphasis on 16-17, and 26*) : Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What difficult circumstance in your life will you, by faith, give thanks for?
- **Confession:** How are you depending upon people to do for you what only God can do for you?

- Read I Corinthians 2:6-16
- How does this passage help confront the problem of division over spiritual teachers and leaders in Corinth?
- What does this passage teach you about the wisdom of God?
- What was the evidence that the rulers of that age did not understand the wisdom of God?
- Why is it impossible for an unbeliever to understand the Scriptures?
- What are some specific situations in which you need the Holy Spirit to give you words to speak?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
