The **Preschool Teacher Assistant** plays a vital role in supporting the lead teacher in creating a nurturing and stimulating learning environment for preschool children. This position involves assisting with classroom activities, supervising children, preparing materials, and maintaining a clean and organized classroom.

If you are at least 18 years of age, have a high school diploma (or equivalent), are willing to complete 45 hours of mandated FL DCF training, First Aid & Pediatric CPR and Fire Extinguisher training, and have experience in childcare or teaching preschool.
