C LOOK BACK

- **BLESS**: How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Revelation 4:1-11:** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What difficult circumstance in your life will you, by faith, give thanks for?
- **Confession:** Invite the Lord to reveal any idols keeping you from serving or causing me to serve for the wrong reasons.

LOOK IN

- Paul warns to "be careful" how we build on the foundation which is Christ. What does it mean to serve God with care in our daily lives?
- Having thought through practical ways you are currently serving in the church and in the community, how can you turn those acts into opportunities to build on the foundation of Jesus Christ?
- Does the reality of the judgement seat, where our service to the Lord -not sin- is evaluated, make you more excited or fearful for that day? Why?
- What does it look like practically to serve "from Him, by Him, for Him," and how will you cultivate this kind of service?
- Two questions are posed," How am I serving?" And "Why am I doing it?". What needs to change in your life to ensure you are serving Christ for the right reasons?
- The first places we can all do something for the right reason is in the home. How are you serving in the home?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
