LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Psalm 133:1:** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)

- **Confession:** How is your response to suffering falling short of the example Jesus set for us on the cross?



LOOK IN

- Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-8. What is the glory robber being confronted with in this passage? What does Paul say we should do as believers instead?
- How does Revelation 20:1-6 support what Paul suggests?
- What would have to be true of the church for you to be willing to act in accordance with this passage in Corinthians?
- Read 1 Peter 2:21-25. What stands out to about the example of Jesus? What was Jesus trusting that caused Him to respond the way He did?
- How would you reply to someone who rejects this 4-step process as unloving?
- What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?

 - Romans 9:12-21
