## A Glory Robber Named "Sexual Immorality"

### LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?
- **Praise: Psalm 32:** Give praise to God for WHO He is and WHAT He has done and an affirmation of where our hope is. (How have you seen him work, answer a prayer, bless you or someone else?)
- The language of our faith is thanksgiving in all things. What difficult circumstance in your life will you, by faith, give thanks for?
- **Confession:** Is there any form of immorality that you need to confess to the Lord?

### LOOK IN

- Read 1 Corinthians 6:12-20 out loud.
- What is God's intent for satisfying sexual desire?
- What are the current cultural thoughts and practices that people verbalize to excuse sexual immorality?
- What is the Biblical rationale for fleeing sexual immorality?
- What actions would you encourage a believer to take who is consistently tempted with sexual immorality?
- What are the rewards of sexual purity?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
