LOOK BACK

- **BLESS:** How has the Spirit of God prompted you to reach out to others in the last week or two? What actions or steps did you take?

- **Confession:** What actions and/or attitudes remain in your life according to who you once were and not you have become in Christ?

LOOK IN

- Why can't the unrighteous inherit the earth?
- What are the differences between being "washed," "justified," and "sanctified"?
- What role does Jesus have in the above three actions? What role does the Holy Spirit have in each of the above three actions? What questions, concerns, or doubts do you have regarding what you have heard and read?
- How did the Holy Spirit speak through this passage to inform, remind, convict, or encourage you?
